Dear Supporter,

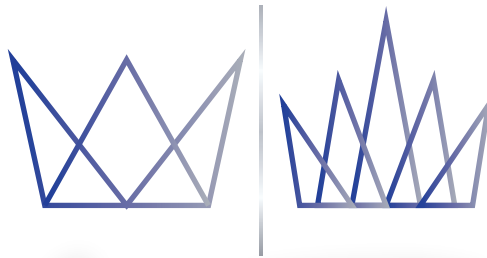

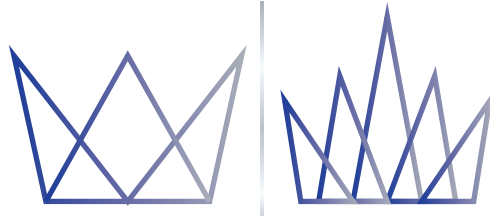
